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Introduction

Spacious six-bedroom home with flexible accommodation on the outskirts of the village of Skerry, in an outstanding location enjoying far reaching views to the sea, Neave Island and across the headland on the North Coast of Scotland.

Bright sitting room with dual aspect windows and multi-fuel stove.

Outstanding views across the sea, islands and surrounding countryside.

Private and peaceful location.



This spacious six-bedroom family home offers accommodation over two floors. The property has flexible living space, making it well suited to family life for those seeking a home in a scenic Highland setting. The property has UPVC double glazing and modern Dimplex heating. The property benefits from fibre optic connection, and there is a 5G mast close by.

A uPVC door opens into the entrance porch, providing space for coats and boots. From here, a door leads into the main hallway.

To the right is the kitchen/dining room, fitted with a good range of cream floor and wall units with work surfaces. Appliances include a Rayburn cooker with hob, fridge/freezer and washing machine. There is ample space for a large dining table. A window to the rear overlooks the garden and a window to the side overlooks surrounding croftland.

To the left of the hallway is a shower room, fitted with a WC, wash hand basin and a large walk-in shower with mains shower.

The sitting room is positioned to the rear of the property and has dual aspect windows, enjoying open views across the sea and towards Neave Island. A multi-fuel stove set within a fireplace with tiled hearth and surround and wooden mantle forms a central feature.



An L-shaped hallway leads to bedroom one, a spacious double room with two windows to the rear, taking in the views. It includes a built-in wardrobe. Bedroom two is another double room with a built-in wardrobe and a window overlooking the surrounding croft land.

Returning to the sitting room, a wooden staircase rises to the upper floor landing, which provides excellent storage including four double cupboards and a further single cupboard.

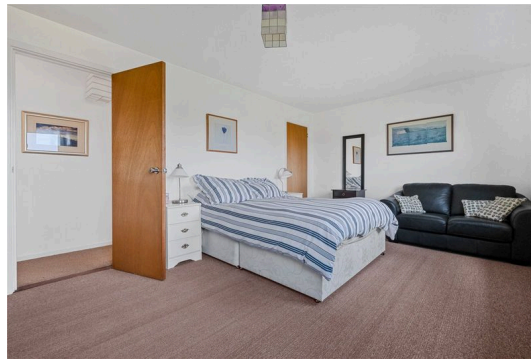
On the upper floor, bedroom three is located to the rear and enjoys open views, with a built-in wardrobe. Bedroom four has a window to the side, taking in views towards the coastline and beaches. Bedroom five is a further double room with a window to the rear, again enjoying similar views. Bedroom six is another double room with a window to the side overlooking the surrounding hills.

Completing the accommodation is the family bathroom, fitted with a WC, wash hand basin and bath. There is also a large partially floored attic.

External

The property sits in garden grounds which are mainly laid to grass, with a field gate and mostly bounded by stock fencing (a fencer has been employed to complete the fencing). There is also a shed included within the grounds. The property is accessed via a track from the public road.







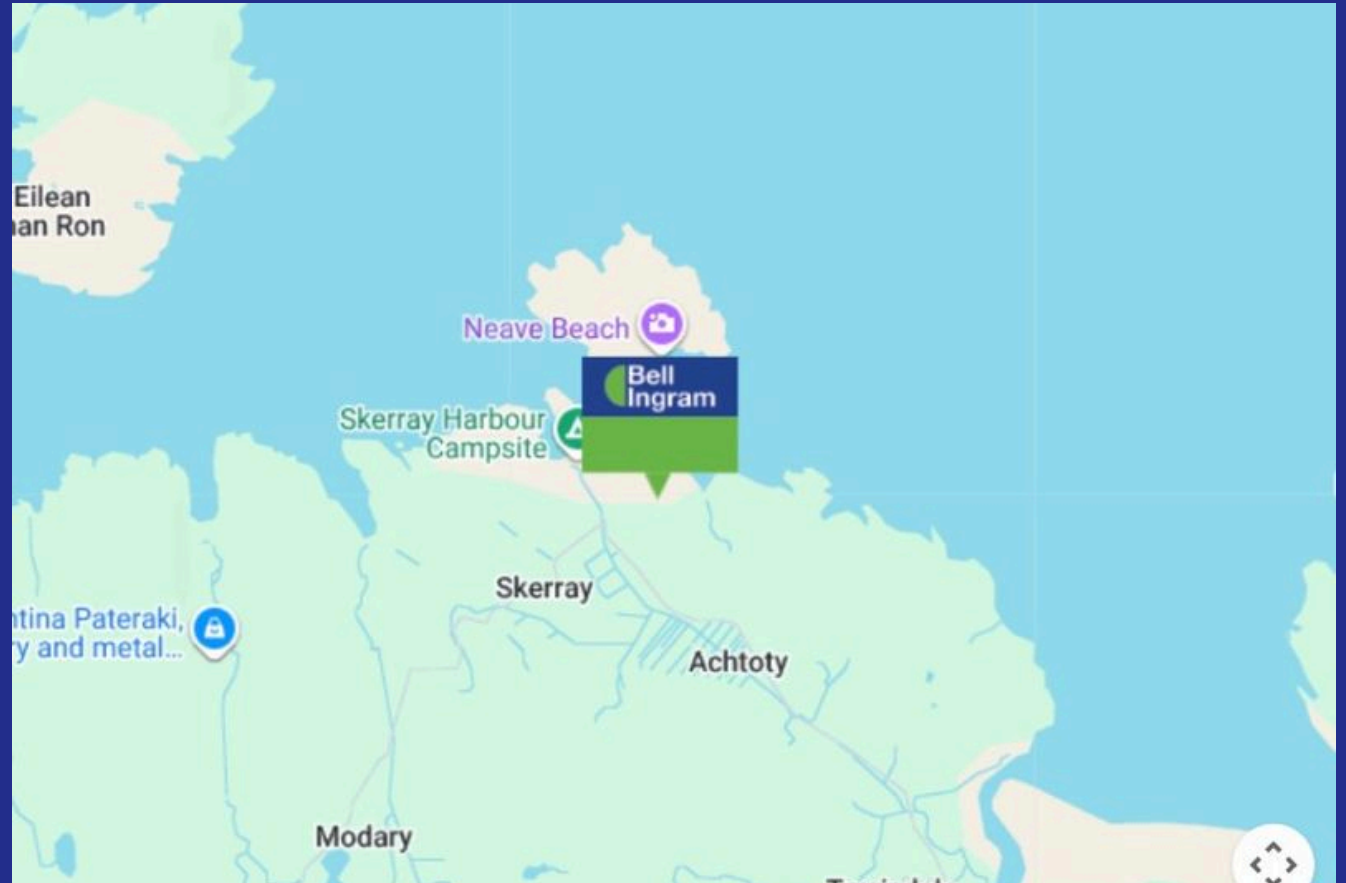
Location

Situated on the outskirts of the village of Skerray, 58 Clashaidy sits in a quiet, elevated location enjoying open views to the sea. It is within minutes of spectacular beaches at both Torrisdale Bay and Coldbackie.

Bettyhill, approximately 10 miles away, is a popular village situated on the dramatic north coast of Scotland. Given its remote location, Bettyhill is well served with local facilities including a Post Office/store/filling station, general stores, hotel, inn, primary school, a very well-respected secondary school, swimming pool and gym.

There are doctors' surgeries at Armadale and Tongue. Further facilities are available at Lairg and Thurso and both towns have railway stations. Tesco also regularly deliver to the area.

There is ample opportunity for recreational activities. The dramatic scenery and wildlife give plenty of scope for the hill walker, mountaineer and country sportsman. The fisherman is well catered for with fishing available on the local lochs and rivers including the excellent River Naver and River Borgie. Torrisdale Bay is popular with surfers and kayakers. The property is also close to the North Coast 500 route.

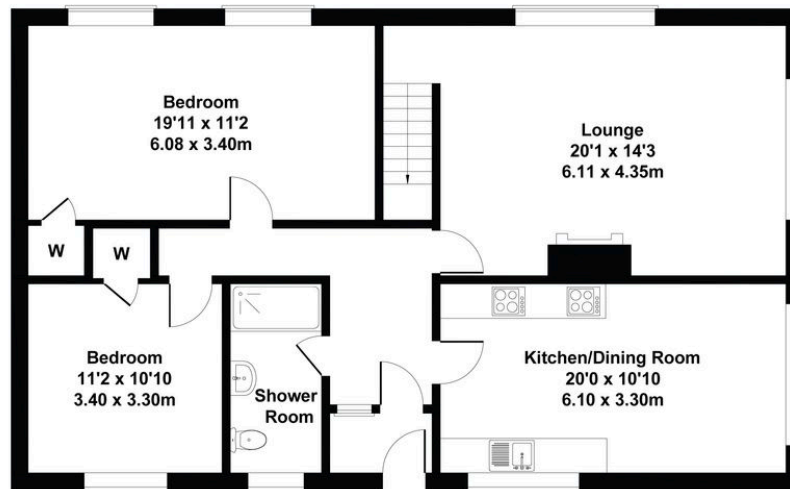

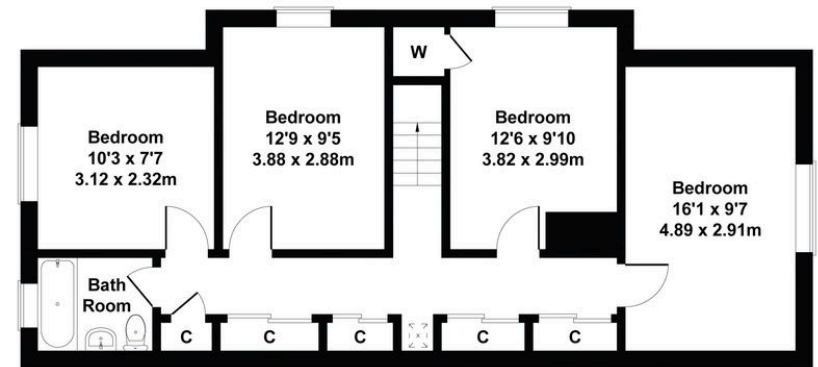

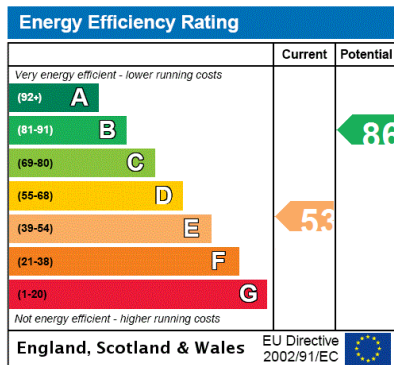

From Lairg travel along the A836 signposted Tongue, when you reach Tongue turn right and follow this road for 4.8 miles until you reach the signpost for Skerray on the left. Follow this road until it starts to drop down towards Skerray Harbour. Follow the road round to the right for 0.5 miles until you reach a road on the right signposted Clashaidy. Go up the hill and at the top of the hill you will see a track on the right. Take this turn and follow the track to the end, 58 is at the end of the track.
